Come visit your community museum, and begin exploring the people and place around you!

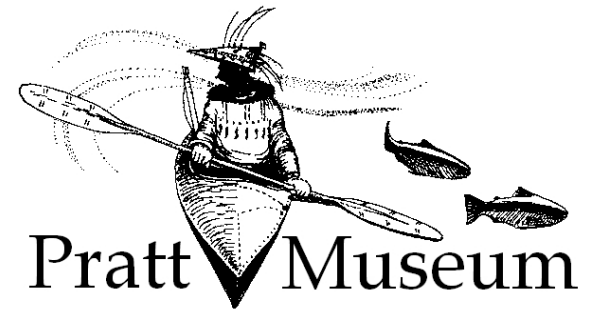
