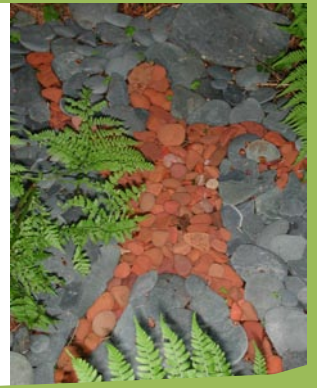


Nature Art Summer Workshop

2pm to 5pm each day

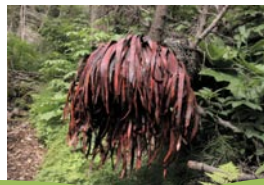
This week long program is open to students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades.

There is no fee to participate.

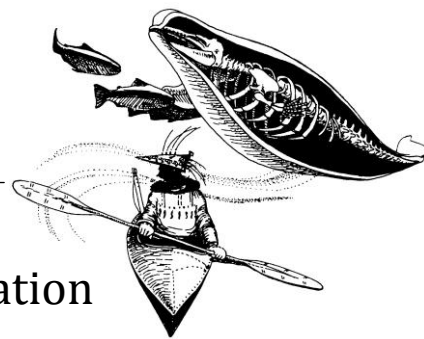
