



## *Gale Parsons Memorial Scholarship*

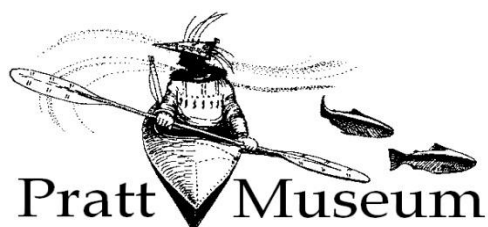
### *Application Form - 2016*

The Gale Parsons Memorial Scholarship was established in 2008 by Gale's friends and family as a way to honor her memory and continue her legacy. Gale was dedicated to nature, cultural understanding and arts education. Gale played a major role in shaping the Pratt Museum's exhibits and educational programs. She worked to strengthen the Museum's relationships with Native villages and tribes. She also helped establish Tamamta Katurlluta, the Gathering of Native Tradition.

**Eligibility Requirements & Award Amount:** An annual Scholarship of \$500 will be awarded each year to a deserving Alaska Native student from the Kachemak Bay region who wishes to pursue formal education in cultural studies or archaeology. Area High School and College students are encouraged to apply. The recipient will also be awarded a travel scholarship to participate in an event or activity of his or her choice, where they will serve as a project assistant during a week of on-site work at the Pratt Museum. During the week of on-site work, the student will work with Museum staff to develop one Object at Hand event (a one hour public program on an artifact of the recipient's choice).

Payment of scholarship funds will be made upon the submission of a short final essay reflecting on the awardee's activities during the project they worked on, to be submitted for the Pratt eNewsletter.
