This position is responsible for the maintenance of the Botanical Garden, as well as nearby grounds and flower beds.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Prepares garden and ornamental beds around the museum and nearby buildings for growing season by clearing debris, planting as needed, fertilizing, etc.
- 2. Provides regular weeding and watering throughout the gardening season; may include lawn care and trail maintenance.
- 3. In coordination with the Facilities Manager, supervises garden volunteers.
- 4. At the end of the season, beds the gardens to protect plants and trees from winter hazards, i.e. moose, heavy snow, cold, etc.
- 5. While on the grounds, interacts with visitors to communicate information on the gardens. May assist with appropriately labeling plants for education purposes.
- 6. Collects plants for habitat areas, as needed. Organizes and conducts annual plant sale, if scheduled.
- 7. Other related duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

Education & Work Experience: At least one year of experience gardening botanicals native to Alaskan ecosystems.

Skills/Abilities: Ability to use gardening tools, ability to work actively (e.g., standing, lifting moderately heavy items, bending, etc.) for extended periods in various weather conditions. Good verbal and written communication skills. Strong skills in problem-solving and prioritizing tasks are essential.
